The man died in HMP Channings Wood in September 2006 at the age of 21 He was found hanging in his cell He had a long history of mental health problems He had been in prison as both a juvenile and adult, and had previously made attempts on his life After a brief period of release on licence, the man had been recalled to HMP Exeter on 6 February
