A Statement of Work (SOW) is typically used when the task is well-known and can be described in specific terms Statement of Objective (SOO) and Performance Work Statement (PWS) emphasize performance-based concepts such as desired service outcomes and performance standards Whereas PWS/SOO's establish high-level outcomes and objectives
